DESIGN


The *CAD* 250 is designed for the automatic removal of unwanted accumulations of oil and water from compressed air lines. The lightweight aluminum housing allows the *CAD* 250 to be installed without the need for mounting brackets. A vent adapter is included to prevent air locking and make installation easy. A 1/4" connection is available for an external balance line if required.

The use of a long lever insures that the float will open the drain when required and provide a high closing pressure to prevent the valve seat from leaking. The valve seat is located well above the bottom of the housing and in a horizontal position to help keep solid particulate from interfering with the operation of the drain. A manual valve is provided that can be opened periodically to remove the accumulated particulate without having to remove the drain from service.

OPERATION

Condensation enters through the top port. A stainless steel float rises with the level of condensation. The float is attached to a lever with the other end of the lever having a seal attached which is pressed against the seat. As the float rises, it exerts a force on the seal to break away from the seat. When the liquid level reaches the desired level, the buoyancy of the float is great enough to pull the seal away from the seat and allow the condensate to pass through the hole in the stainless steel seat. As the condensation is expelled, the float returns to its normally closed position forcing the seal against the seat.

The **CAD 250** is designed to require a minimum amount of maintenance. The use of non-corrosive materials for the drain's internal mechanism further insures trouble free operation.
